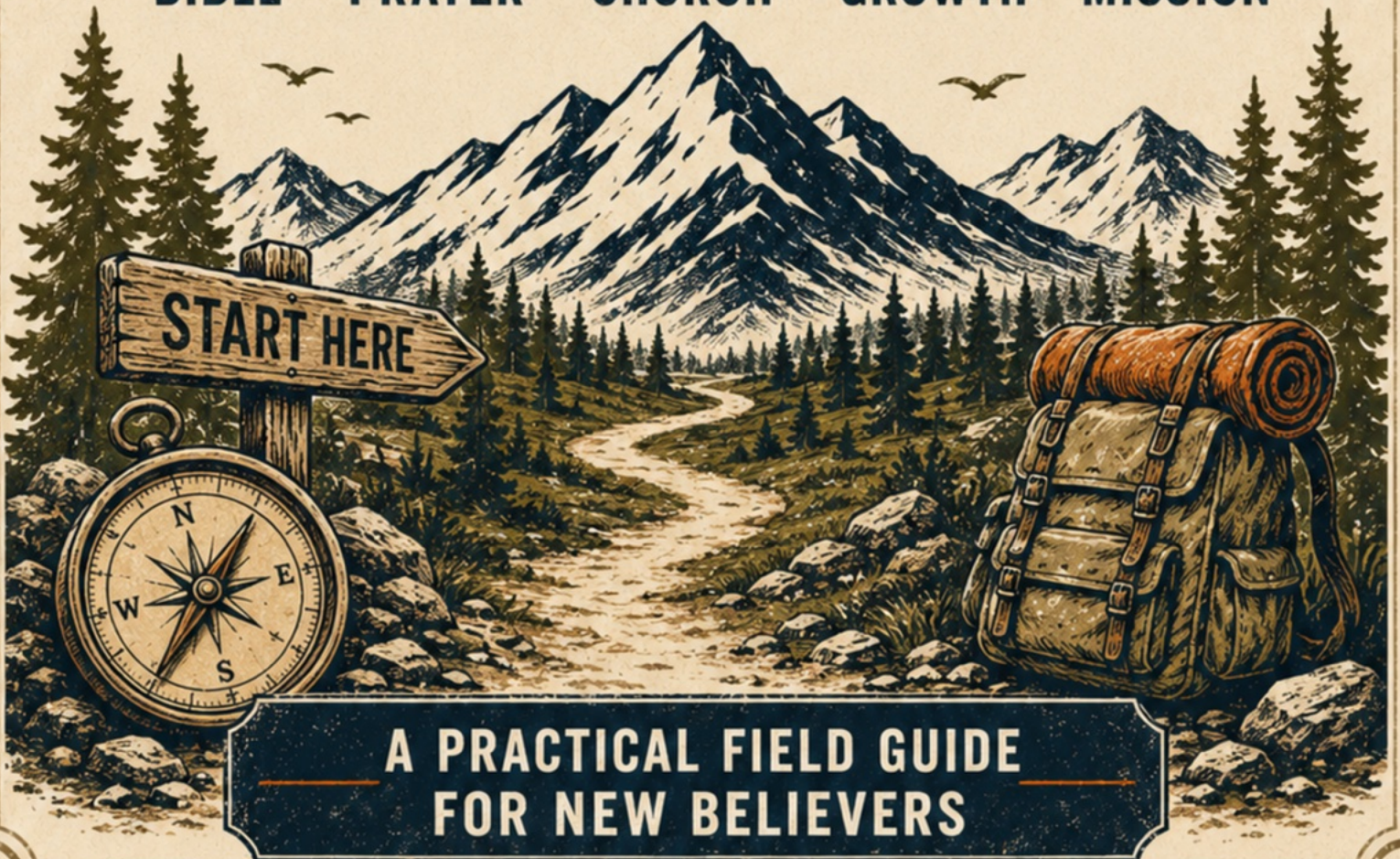

DAY 1

UNDERSTAND WHAT HAPPENED

I Have Been Saved by Jesus

Becoming a Christian is more than becoming religious or trying to be a better person. You were separated from God because of sin, but Jesus Christ died for your sins and rose again. When you repented and trusted Christ, God forgave you, saved you, and brought you into His family.

THE GOSPEL IN FOUR TRUTHS



1 I HAVE SINNED

"For all have sinned, and come short of the glory of God."
— Romans 3:23

Sin is anything we think, say, or do that goes against God. No amount of good behavior can erase our sin.



2 SIN BRINGS DEATH

"For the wages of sin is death; but the gift of God is eternal life through Jesus Christ our Lord." — Romans 6:23

We deserve judgment, but God offers eternal life as a gift.



3 JESUS DIED AND ROSE AGAIN

"But God commendeth his love toward us, in that, while we were yet sinners, Christ died for us." — Romans 5:8

Jesus took the punishment we deserved. He was buried and rose bodily from the dead.



4 I AM SAVED BY TRUSTING JESUS

"For whosoever shall call upon the name of the Lord shall be saved." — Romans 10:13

Salvation is received by grace through faith. It cannot be earned by good works.

LEARN TO PRAY

Talk with Your Father

Prayer is speaking with God through Jesus Christ. You do not need impressive words. You can come honestly, humbly, and confidently because God is your Father.

“Let us therefore come boldly unto the throne of grace, that we may obtain mercy, and find grace to help in time of need.”

HEBREWS 4:16

USE THE P.R.A.Y. PATTERN

P



P — PRAISE

Tell God who He is and thank Him for what He has done.

R



R — REPENT

Confess your sins honestly and turn from them.

A



A — ASK

Bring your needs and the needs of others to God.

Y



Y — YIELD

Place your plans, desires, and decisions under God's will.

DAY 5



CONNECT WITH A CHURCH

Do Not Walk Alone

The Christian life was never meant to be lived alone. God places believers in a local church where they worship, learn Scripture, pray, serve, and carry out Christ's mission together.

"And they continued stedfastly in the apostles' doctrine and fellowship, and in breaking of bread, and in prayers."

ACTS 2:42

WHY DO I NEED A CHURCH?



A healthy local church helps me:

- Learn and obey the Bible.
- Worship with other believers.
- Build Christian friendships.
- Receive encouragement and correction.
- Discover opportunities to serve.
- Care for people who are hurting.
- Share the gospel with the community.
- Remain accountable in my walk with Christ.

"Not forsaking the assembling of ourselves together, as the manner of some is; but exhorting one another."

HEBREWS 10:25

WHAT SHOULD I LOOK FOR?



Look for a church that:

- Faithfully teaches the Bible.
- Clearly proclaims the gospel.
- Believes salvation is through Jesus Christ.
- Practices prayer and Christian fellowship.
- Helps believers grow and serve.
- Seeks to obey the commands of Jesus.

No church is perfect because every church is made of imperfect people. Look for faithfulness, not perfection.

TAKE YOUR FIRST PUBLIC STEP

Follow Jesus in Baptism

Baptism is the first public step of obedience for a believer. It shows that you have trusted Jesus and now belong to Him. Baptism pictures the death, burial, and resurrection of Christ—and the new life He has given you.

“Therefore we are buried with him by baptism into death: that like as Christ was raised up from the dead... even so we also should walk in newness of life.”

ROMANS 6:4

WHAT BAPTISM DOES NOT DO



- Earn salvation.
- Wash away sin by itself.
- Replace personal faith in Jesus.
- Make someone a Christian without repentance and faith.

We are saved by God’s grace through faith in Jesus Christ. Baptism is an outward testimony of the salvation we have already received.

WHAT BAPTISM DECLARES



- I believe Jesus died and rose again.
- I have trusted Jesus as my Saviour.
- My old life no longer rules me.
- I belong to Jesus Christ.
- I intend to follow Him with His church.

KNOW THE HOLY SPIRIT

— God Is at Work Within You —

The Holy Spirit is God—not a force, mood, or vague spiritual feeling. He lives within every true believer and works to make us more like Jesus.

“Know ye not that ye are the temple of God, and that the Spirit of God dwelleth in you?”

1 CORINTHIANS 3:16

WHAT DOES THE HOLY SPIRIT DO?



- Lives within every believer.
- Points people to Jesus Christ.
- Helps us understand spiritual truth.
- Convicts us when we sin.
- Gives us power to obey and serve.
- Helps us pray.
- Produces Christlike character in us.

GROWTH IS USUALLY GRADUAL

Do not confuse slow growth with no growth. God changes His people over time.

LOOK FOR:

- A new direction in life.
- Increasing obedience.
- Quicker repentance.
- A growing love for Jesus.
- A greater concern for others.
- A deeper desire for God’s Word.



THE FRUIT OF THE SPIRIT

“But the fruit of the Spirit is love, joy, peace, longsuffering, gentleness, goodness, faith, meekness, temperance.”

— GALATIANS 5:22–23 —



Fruit grows as we remain close to Christ, believe His Word, obey His commands, and depend upon His Spirit.

FIGHT SIN AND TEMPTATION

— Run to God, Not Away

Christians still face temptation. You may stumble, but sin is no longer your master. God gives you His Spirit, His Word, His people, and a way of escape.

"For sin shall not have dominion over you."

— ROMANS 6:14

USE THE E.S.C.A.P.E. PLAN

E



E — EXPECT TEMPTATION

Do not be shocked when temptation comes. Stay watchful.

S



S — SEE THE DANGER

Sin may promise pleasure, but it brings pain, distance, and destruction.

C



C — CALL ON GOD

Pray immediately. Ask God for strength and a clear way out.

A



A — ANSWER WITH SCRIPTURE

Jesus answered temptation with God's Word. Keep helpful verses ready.

P



P — PUT DISTANCE BETWEEN YOU AND THE SIN

Leave the room, close the app, end the conversation, or change the situation.

E



E — ENGAGE ANOTHER BELIEVER

Ask a trustworthy Christian to pray with you and keep you accountable.

"God is faithful, who will not suffer you to be tempted above that ye are able; but will with the temptation also make a way to escape."

— 1 CORINTHIANS 10:13

TEMPTATION IS NOT THE SAME AS SIN

Jesus was tempted, yet He never sinned. Temptation becomes sin when we welcome, believe, or act upon it.

DAY 9

KNOW WHAT TO DO WHEN YOU SIN

— Confess, Turn, and Return —

RETURN
TO
GOD

Becoming a Christian does not mean you will never sin again. It means you now belong to Jesus and cannot be satisfied living under sin's control. When you sin, do not hide from God. Run back to Him.

"IF WE CONFESS OUR SINS, HE IS FAITHFUL AND JUST TO FORGIVE US OUR SINS, AND TO CLEANSE US FROM ALL UNRIGHTEOUSNESS."

— 1 JOHN 1:9

FIVE STEPS AFTER YOU SIN

1



1 — CONFESS IT

Agree with God about what you did. Do not excuse, rename, or hide it.

2



2 — TURN FROM IT

Repentance means changing direction. Ask God to help you leave the sin behind.

3



3 — TRUST GOD'S FORGIVENESS

Jesus paid for your sin. Do not keep punishing yourself for sin you have honestly confessed.

4



4 — MAKE IT RIGHT

Apologize, return what was taken, correct what was false, or repair the harm when possible.

5



5 — LEARN FROM IT

Notice what led to the fall. Prepare a wiser response for next time.

CONVICTION OR CONDEMNATION?

CONVICTION



This was sin. Confess it and return to God.

CONDEMNATION



You are hopeless. Hide from God and give up.

Godly conviction leads us toward repentance and restoration.

"THERE IS THEREFORE NOW NO CONDEMNATION TO THEM WHICH ARE IN CHRIST JESUS."

— ROMANS 8:1

BRING IT INTO THE LIGHT



What do I need to confess to God?

DAY 10

LEARN YOUR NEW IDENTITY

— Remember Who You Are in Christ —



The world tries to define you by your success, failure, appearance, past, possessions, or popularity. The gospel gives you a new identity. Your greatest identity is now found in your relationship with Jesus Christ.

“Therefore if any man be in Christ, he is a new creature: old things are passed away; behold, all things are become new.”

— 2 CORINTHIANS 5:17

DAY 11

“If ye love me, keep my commandments.”

— JOHN 14:15

Encourage someone who is hurting.



Help with a practical need.



Welcome someone at church.



Pray with another person.



Visit someone who is lonely.



Help a neighbor.



Use your abilities to strengthen the church.



Give faithfully and generously.



Share your home, food, time, or attention.



Do an unnoticed task with joy.

LEARN TO GIVE

Everything you possess ultimately belongs to God. Christian giving is a response of worship, gratitude, trust, and love.



“Every man according as he purposeth in his heart, so let him give; not grudgingly, or of necessity: for God loveth a cheerful giver.”

— 2 CORINTHIANS 9:7

Cheerful rather than resentful.



Thoughtful rather than careless.



Generous rather than self-centered.



Directed toward God's work and people in need.
